BUILT: 1895-1896

ARCHITECT: Louis Sullivan and Dankmar Adler of the firm Adler & Sullivan

STYLE: Modern Skyscraper / Art Nouveau

GUARANTY BUILDING

- "Guaranty" vs. "Prudential"
- Adler & Sullivan: designers of the first modern skyscraper
- Demolition threatened after 1974 fire
- Saved & restored 1982-1983
- Currently owned by Hodgson Russ

7 ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

BUILT: 1849-1851

ARCHITECT: Richard Upjohn

STYLE: Gothic Revival

ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL


- Incorporated in 1817

- 1848 Building designed by Richard Upjohn
- 1888 Explosion & Rebuilding




ST. PAUL'S CATHEDRAL interior – stained glass



"Ascension"

- Made by Holiday & Co. of London
- Depicts the Ascension of Christ: 11 disciples and Mary gazing upward at Christ ascending
- Rose window above displays symbols in red representing the 4 Evangelists

- The upper left-hand side: Smokestacks from steel plants on Lake Erie

- More recent addition from the 1950s


8 ONE M&T PLAZA
