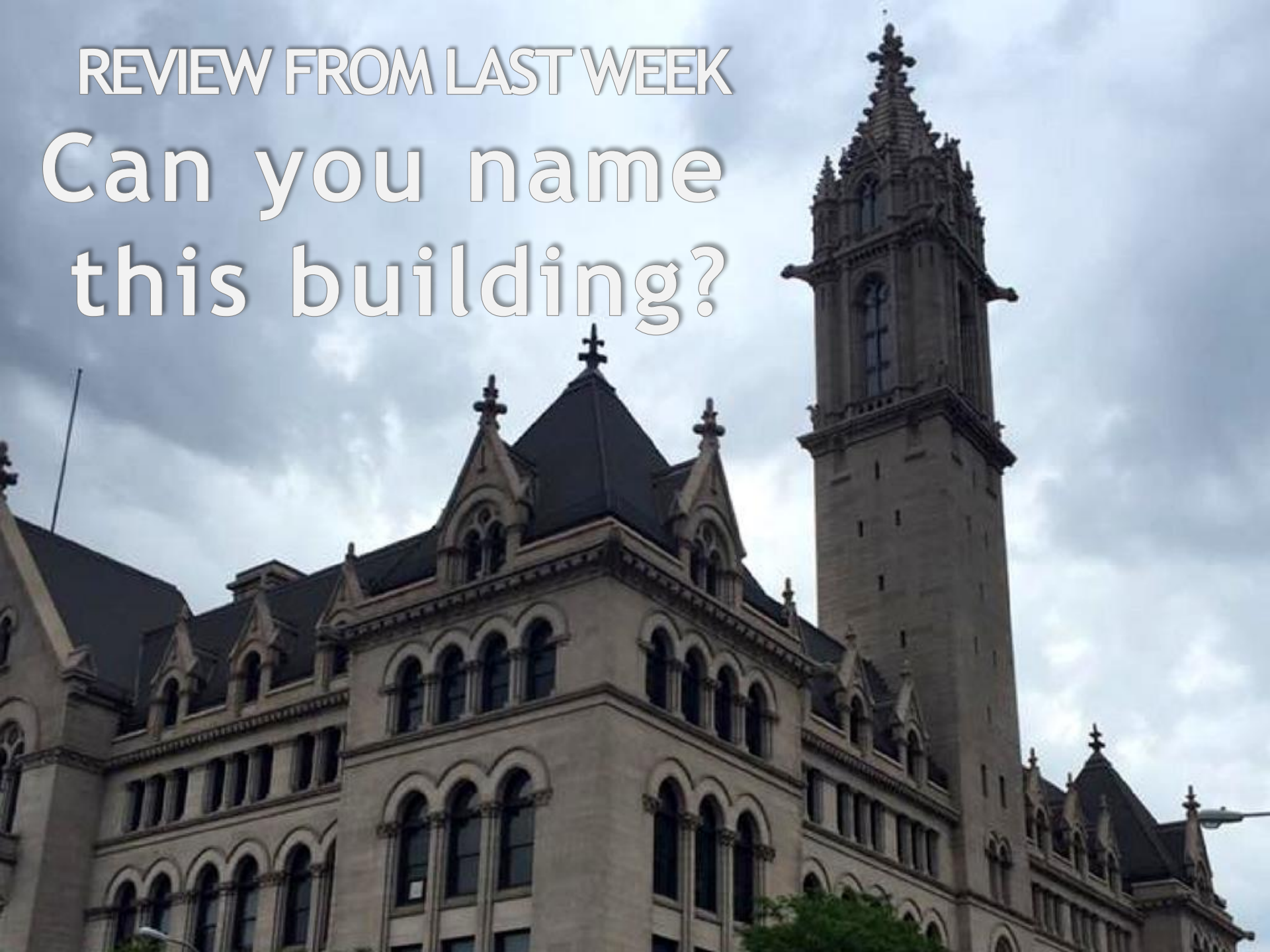

STYLE: Gothic Revival



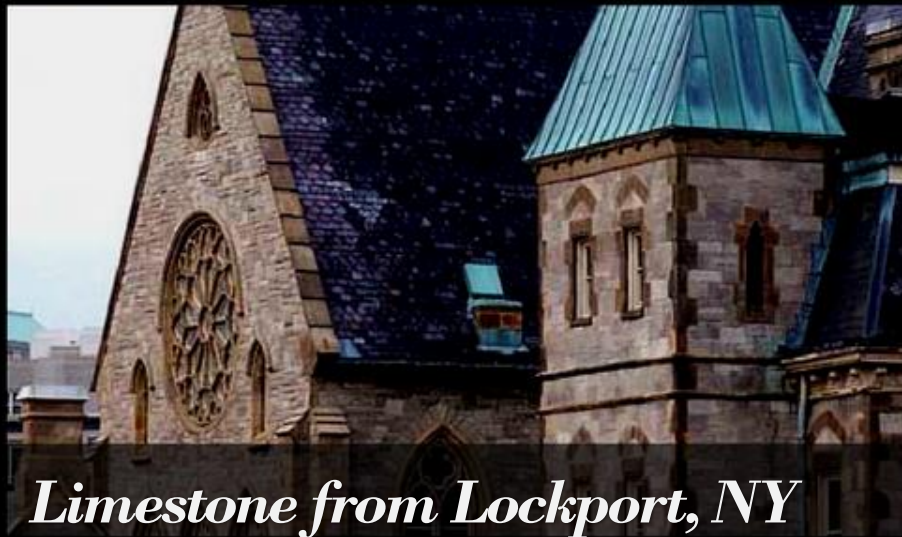
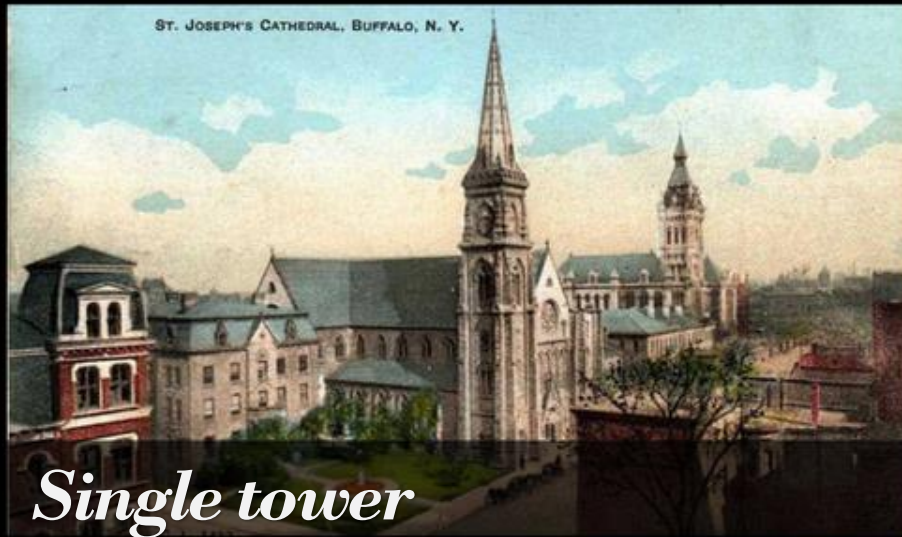
ST. JOSEPH'S CATHEDRAL

- Timon: 1st R.C. Bishop of Buffalo (1847)
- Identified with poor Irish workers
- Traveled the world to raise money for a new cathedral
- 1847-1897 Diocese grew from 16 to 200 churches
- Laid to rest in St. Joseph's

OLD COUNTY HALL

BUILT: 1871-1876

ARCHITECT: Andrew Jackson Warner

STYLE: Late Victorian Romanesque

OLD COUNTY HALL



- Historical site going back to War of 1812
- Location of one of Buffalo's first burial grounds
- Originally City and County Hall
- 1901 McKinley assassination connection
